Solo show

Neither Visible Nor Invisible

DL gallery presents on Saturday 29/05/2021 the solo show of Michalis Karaiskos “Neither Visible Nor Invisible”.

Products of a time-consuming and exacting manual processing, the works of Michalis Karaiskos do not stop at the striking outcome which, thanks precisely to their geometric rigour, resembles a digital processing. Much more than that, they manage to convey the aspiration for a 'poetics' of light (with or without inverted commas).

A catalytic element in this equation is the underlying background of Karaiskos's approach to art making, namely his painstaking observation from life, which feeds into the fully abstract outcome of the final works together with pragmatist and reflective issues of painting.

The treatment of the works is reinforced with a selective use of colour, surfaces of alternating sizes, the coexistence of canvas and paper and the introduction of materials such as thread, which may not belong to the arsenal of painting but come to serve its purpose.
